

MESSAGE FROM THE CEO

I am delighted to report that the Kata Rocks Superyacht Rendezvous (KRSR) 2019 once again showed why it is considered one of the best events of its kind in Asia. Sponsored by Infinite Luxury, the fourth annual KRSR concluded with a 'Soiree by The Sea' Charity Gala Dinner. The ultra-exclusive event was hosted at Kata Rocks on behalf of The International SeaKeepers Society, Asia and Phuket-based Oceans For All Foundation and sponsored by the Leading Yachts of the World. It aimed to raise awareness and contribute to marine conservation and oceanographic research that together can help protect and restore our oceans for generations to come.

KRSR extended its charitable philanthropy with a silent auction that included a Triton Subphotique timepiece, a bespoke Soiree by The Sea charm, an iAQUA Stingray watercraft, plus a Royal Thai Navy memorabilia shirt worn during the cave rescue of the Wild Boar football team in Chiang Rai. Another surprise addition was a stunning Tanzanite ring generously sponsored by Fred Mouawad, the Co-Guardian of Mouawad, and valued at over two million baht. All told, the 'Soiree by The Sea' Charity Gala Dinner and silent auction raised substantial amount with proceeds going to the charities. We are very proud of these endeavours which iniated KRSR's leadership role in marine conservation and philanthropy for the first time. The KRSR also led a unique educational beach clean-up and yoga session, once again in partnership with The International SeaKeepers Society, Asia and Oceans For All, in early December 2019 as part of its pre-event initiatives.

Last year the rendezvous enjoyed idyllic weather conditions as participants spent more time cruising along Phuket's sun kissed west coast than ever before. They were treated to one-of-a-kind welcome experience onboard Lobster Yacht, Thailand's largest and coolest catamaran, which made its debut for the first time at the KRSR. Held in partnership with Seven Marine Phuket, this unique welcome experience kickstarted the four-day event in classic KRSR style.

The annual superyacht parade took participants up the coast to the InterContinental Phuket Resort, Kamala Beach showcasing its spectacular beachfront location, sponsoring KRSR's best beach barbeques ever. Benetti also pitched in by hosting a pop up spa during the event, offering attendees a wellness experience complementing the serene setting.




Founded in 1998 by a group of yach towners outraged by the degradation of our oceans, the nonprofit's Scientific Security Council outlined its goals in a mission statement that said they wished "to inspire the leaders of the world to become a voice for the oceans by bridging gaps between good science and the business and yachting communities".

In practical terms, this means that yacht owners will help with oceanographic research by providing a vessel so marine scientists can work on projects like shark tagging, coral reef research and water quality

What is the idea behind the KRSR?


